

## **COOKIES POLICY**

Access to this website may involve the use of cookies. Cookies are small amounts of information that are stored in the browser used by each user on the different devices that can be used to navigate so that the server remembers certain information that later and only the server that implemented it will read.

Cookies facilitate navigation, make it more friendly and not damage navigation device.

Cookies are automatic procedures for collecting information regarding the preferences determined by the user during his visit to the website to recognize him as a user, and personalize his experience and use of website, and can also, for example, help to identify and resolve bugs.

The information collected through cookies may include the date and time of visits to the website, the pages viewed, the time spent on the website and the sites visited just before and after it. However, no cookie allows it to contact the user's phone number or any other means of personal contact.

No cookie can extract information from the user's hard drive or steal personal information. The only way that the user's private information is part of the cookie file is for the user to personally give that information to the server.

Cookies that allow you to identify a person are considered personal data. Therefore, the Privacy Policy described above will apply to them. In this sense, for the use of the same the consent of the user will be necessary. This consent will be communicated, according to an authentic choice, offered by an affirmative and positive decision, before the initial, removable and documented treatment.

## **OWN COOKIES**

These are those cookies that are on the user's computer or device and managed exclusively by *Museu de la Pesca* for the best functioning of the website. The information that is collected is used to improve the quality of the website and its content and user's experience. These cookies allow The User to be recognized as a recurring visitor to the website and adapt the content to offer content that suits their preferences.

## **THIRD PARTY COOKIES**

These cookies are used and managed by external entities that provide the *Museu de la Pesca* with services requested by it to improve the website and the user experience when browsing it. The main objectives for which third-party cookies are used are to obtain access statistics and analyse navigation information, that is, how the user interacts with the Website.

The information obtained refers, for example, to the number of pages visited, the language, the place of the IP address from which the User accesses, the number of users who access, the frequency and recurrence of visits, the time visit, the browser they use, the operator or type of device from which the visit is made. This information is used to improve the website, and detect new needs to offer Users a Content and / or service of the highest quality.

In any case, information is collected anonymously and website trend reports are prepared without identifying individual users.

### **DEACTIVATE, REJECT AND DELETE COOKIES**

The user can deactivate, reject and delete the cookies -totally or partially- installed on their device through the configuration of their browser (among which are, for example, Chrome, Firefox, Safari, Explorer). In this sense, the procedures for rejecting and deleting cookies may differ from one Internet browser to another. Consequently, the user must go to the instructions provided by the Internet browser they use. In the event that you reject the use of cookies -totally or partially- you may continue using the website, although you may have limited use of some of its features.
